Discussion

HB 2460 requires that two percent of Capital Construction appropriations for state buildings be used for the acquisition of works of art through the Oregon Arts Commission. It is assumed that the recommended Capital Construction projects for the 1975-77 biennium will not be increased by two percent, but rather that two percent of the currently recommended amounts will be used by the Oregon Arts Commission to carry out the provisions of this bill. This results in no overall dollar impact on the state, rather a redistribution of approved Capital Construction funds and a two percent reduction in either the quality or size of the basic structures being built. *- Higher Education*
