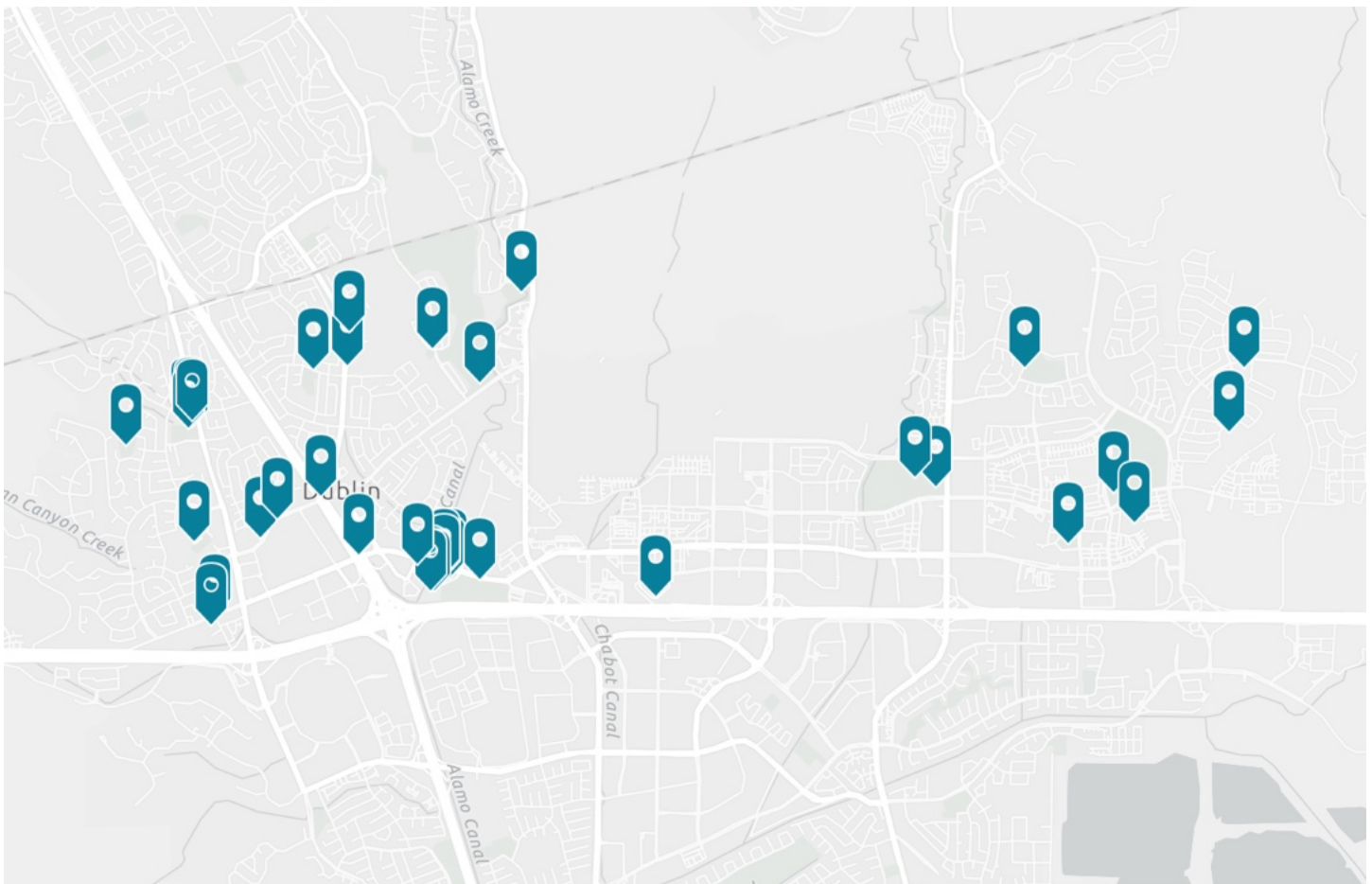

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Berry, Roger | 1983

This crown-like sculpture by Roger Berry is located in front of Dublin's Civic Center. It is created by a series of zig zag cut panels of steel, welded together, and attached at two...



Benton, Fletcher | 1989

Created in 1989 by Fletcher Benton, and located at the Civic Center, "Steel Watercolor #99" has been a part of the Dublin landscape since it was placed here on loan in 1996....



Voulkos, Peter | 1990

The large-scale abstract bronze sculpture that now sits in front of Shannon Community Center is one of the most significant and valuable pieces in the City of Dublin's art...



Smyth, Ned | 1991

"Gaia", a gift from the Dublin Fine Arts Foundation is a 9' fiberglass, stone and glass mosaic globe that sits at the center of a fountain in the Dublin Civic Center's courtyard...



Keefer, Katherine | 1994

Located in the lobby entrance of Dublin's Civic Center, "Gail" was a gift from the Dublin Fine Arts Foundation. She a ceramic female figure reading a book while seated on a...



Arthur, Twyla | 1996

Located at Stagecoach Park, "Mosaic Benches," by artist Twyla Arthur, features a mosaic tile seating area, benches, and a tile planter overlaid with jewel-hued tiles. The front...



Counihan, Alan | 1997

Commissioned by the City of Dublin, "Black Pool" is located in Alamo Creek Park. It was created by artist Alan Counihan of Dublin, Ireland. The work serves as a visual link or...



Keefer, Katherine | 1999

Aaron and Dylan can be found seated on a bench at the back of the City Hall courtyard. This life-size ceramic sculpture of a father tying his young son's shoe is by the same...



Billick, Donna & Troy Corliss | 1999

"Archway", located at Mape Memorial Park, was created by two Mosaic artists from Dublin, Donna Billick and Troy Corliss. The surface of the entire arch structure is...



King, John | 2000

Created by artist John King of Eureka, California and located in Kolb Park, "Dust in the Universe" uses a concrete tile "floor" to represent themes in particle physics. John...



Poethig, Johanna | 2002

"Birdwatch" is one of Dublin's most colorful pieces stretching 158' long with a 4' tall scrub jay that holds the place of honor at the center of this mural, celebrating Californ...



Schmidt, Linda | 2002

The 20th Anniversary Quilt hangs in the entrance lobby at 100 Civic Plaza. Completed in 2001; the quilt is machine and hand sewn fabric, chains, and lace. Fabric types includ...



Evans, Mark & Charlie Brown | 2003

Mark Evans and Charley Brown each with a solo career are artists in their own right but working together became known for turning flat walls into theatrical productions...



Galvez, Daniel & John Pugh, John Wehrle | 2003

“Historic Crossroads” is located on the freeway underpasses of I-680 at Dublin Boulevard and Amador Valley Boulevard. Created by a team of artists, these interior...



Ellison, Robert | 2003

This sculpture by Roger Ellison depicts two arching pillars framing the entrance of the Dublin Library. The pillar on the right side of the entrance has an open book on top. T...



Galvez, Daniel & John Pugh, John Wehrle | 2003

“Historic Crossroads” is located on the freeway underpasses of I-680 at Dublin Boulevard and Amador Valley Boulevard. Created by a team of artists, these interior...



Mollica, Peter | 2003

“Seasons”, a circular stained-glass window, can be found in the Dublin Library Rotunda. It was created by Peter Mollica who received his formal training making traditional...



Dykes, Dan | 2004

“Rolling Hills” are a set of three bus shelters designed by Dan Dykes, fabricated in stainless steel. They have two main seating elements. The main area is a traditional,...



Kahn, Ned | 2004

“Divided Sea” is a 100’ arc of polished stainless-steel fountains that spray sheets of water that move like fabric in the wind that was gifted by the Dublin Fine Arts...



Tedrick, Bryan | 2004

Located at Dolan Park, “Dreams of Longing After Nothing” is a kinetic sculpture powered by Dublin’s ever-present afternoon winds. Its 14-foot-long steel-and-bronze...



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Cheney, Rowland | 2005

As you pass the Dublin Senior Center on Amador Valley Boulevard, you'll catch a glimpse of a crane 's head rising above the wall. Rowland Cheney's bronze sculpture...



Gould, Bill | 2007

Located near the children's playground in Bray Commons Park, Tranquility provides shade, sound and whimsy to the surrounding environment. The leaf shapes were...



Lambert, Colin | 2009

Located at the Shannon Community Center, this is a large wall panel relief made of acrylic modeling paste. It depicts a mature Valley Oak Tree in a grassy foreground wit...



George, Tricia | 2009

Located at the Shannon Community Center preschool area, "Community" consists of simple building blocks painted in a trompe l'oeil (to deceive the eye) . The blocks...



Soyfertis, Margarita | 2009

"And There Was Evening and There Was Morning" was created by Margarita Soyfertis, a multi-faceted artist who began her work in theatre design. In the early 2000s,...



George, Tricia | 2009

"In My World was also painted by Tricia George, the creator of "Community", both of which are located at the Shannon Community Center. " In My World" works directly...



Garten, Cliff | 2011

Located at the Dublin Transit Center, the “Dubliner” is made of brushed stainless-steel rods, the sculpture’s volume catches sunlight during the day and transforms itself into...



Satow, Heath | 2017

Towering 31 feet above Fallon Sports Park’s - Field Four you’ll find “Elatus”. This abstract sculpture is inspired by the athletic human form in full extension, suggesting ...



Kurtzman, Todji | 2017

The sculpture 'Thank You, Water' is an offering of gratitude to the Spirit of Alamilla Spring and all waters. The concept and bronzes were created and sculpted by artist...



Huether, Gordon | 2019

“The Ribbon” located at the Dublin Safety Complex, was designed with the Dublin Police and Fire Services equally in mind and embodies the symbol of the remembrance...



Grygutis, Barbara | 2020

“Conversation”, intended to embrace our shared humanity, located at the All Abilities Playground at Dublin Sports Ground, has been designed to emphasize and highlight a...



Colin Selig | 2020

Arachnicat is a whimsical biomorphic sculpture climbing up out of the adjacent creek to explore Clover Park. Arachnicat is a playful, brightly colored focal point for the par...



Taylor, Yoshio | 2020

Located at Jordan Ranch Park, Progression reflects a beautiful natural environment and shows some of the historical significance of Dublin and its surrounding area. One of t...



Tellart | 2020

Dogs of Dublin is a colorful and community-generated art piece. This work consists of a series of brightly-colored laser-cut steel silhouettes of dogs, including many who...

Rideart Studios | 2021

Located at Sean Diamond Park, Diamond's in the Wind is an 18' high kinetic wind sculpture made of stainless steel. This large iconic sculpture features two diamond...

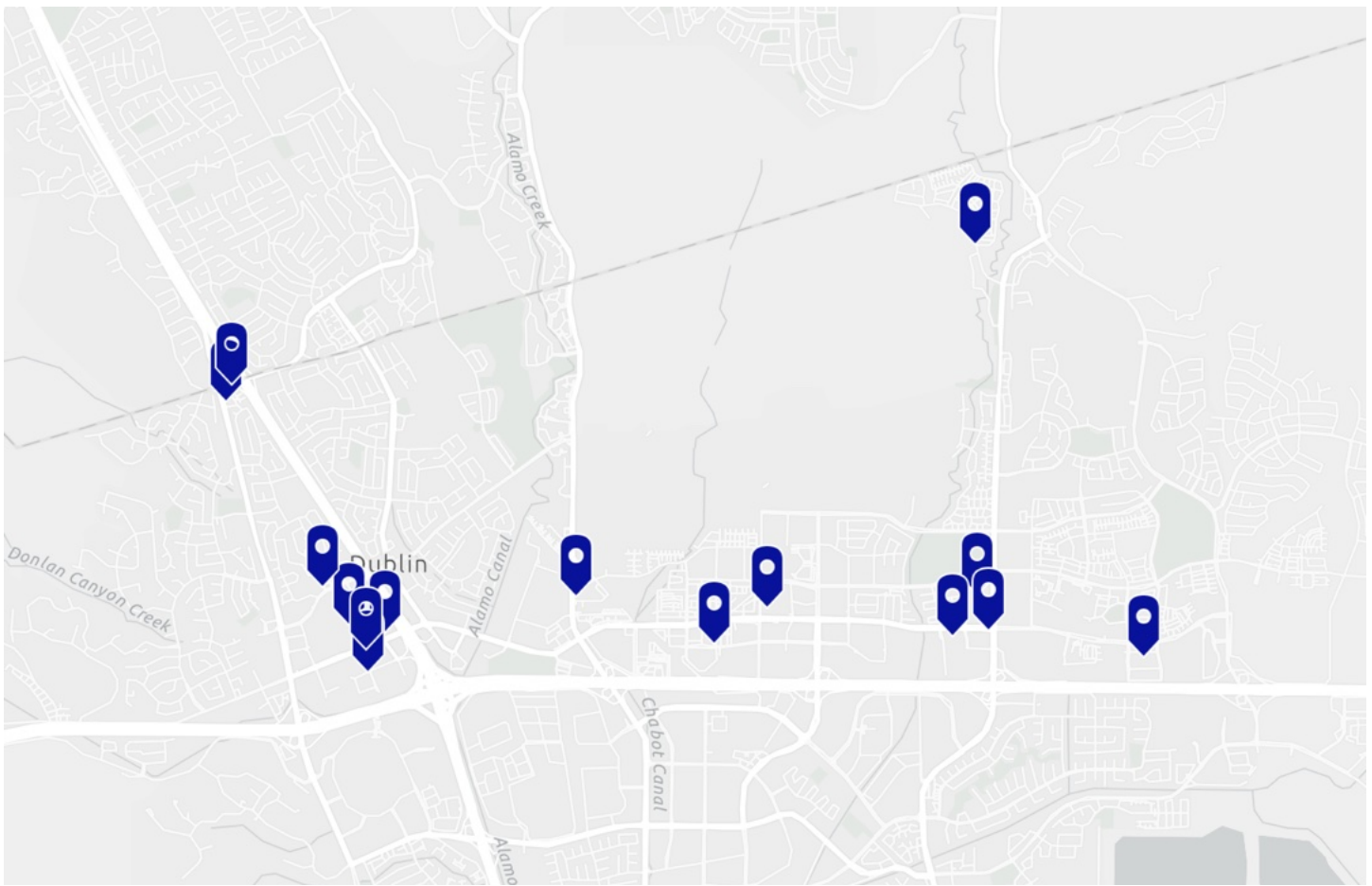
Keith, Brian | 2023

While Wallis Ranch community neighborhood was being built artist Eric Powell designed a series of art pieces that would be installed throughout the development. T...

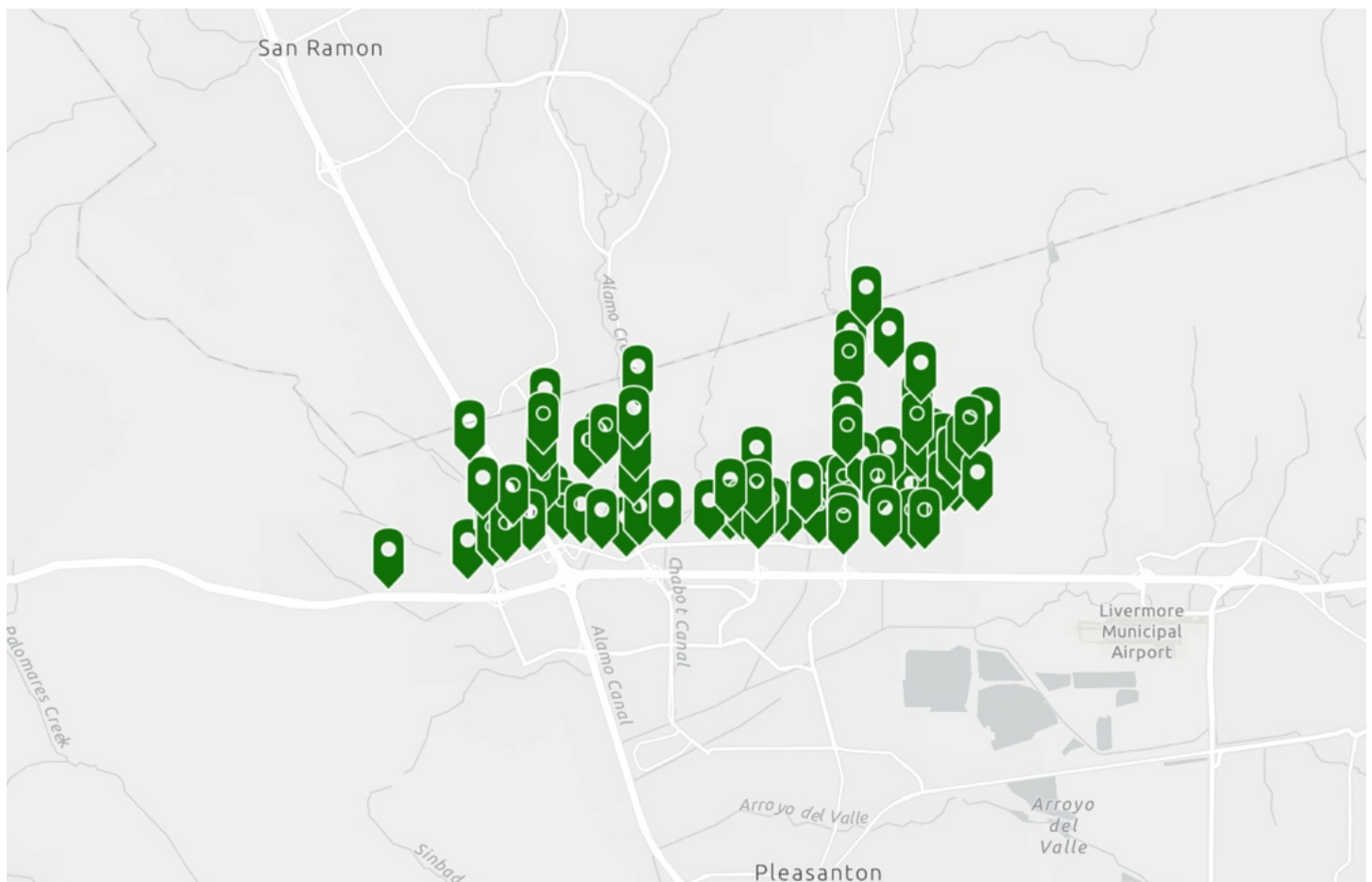
Mathew Placzek | 2020
